

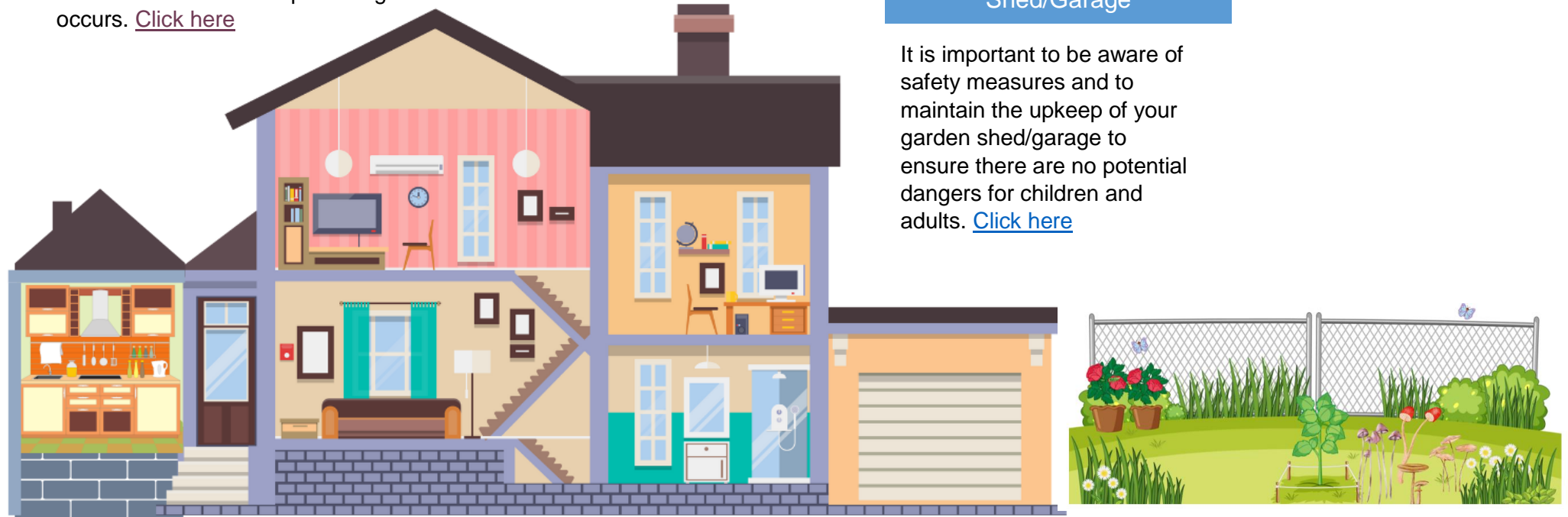
## Home and Garden Safety
